

Cookie Policy

Consent

By using the Corporate and Sporting Events Management (CSE) website you consent to the use of cookies in agreement with this policy. Upon your first visit to the site, you will have seen a pop-up cookie consent banner on your browser; although it will does not appear on further visits, you may revoke your consent at any time by following the Disabling Cookies guidance below.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the initial web domain on all visits to that domain following. Most web pages contain elements from multiple web domains, when you visit the Website, your browser may receive cookies from numerous sources. Cookies are beneficial since they allow a website to recognise a user's device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and largely improve the user experience. They are also used to direct advertising to your interests through monitoring your browsing across websites. Session cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser and persistent cookies remain on your device after the internet browser is closed (for example to remember your user preferences when you return to the site).

Disabling cookies

If you do not agree to the use of these cookies, please disable them by following the instructions for your chosen browser or use the automated disabling tools where accessible. Please note that some services will not function as well if cookies are disabled. Some browsers make it possible for you to decide that you do not want your internet browsing activity to be tracked. Disabling tracking may interfere with the performance of the website After your initial visit to the website we may change the cookies we use. We commit to enabling you to always know who is placing cookies, for what purpose they are being set, and give you the means to disable them. We would advise you to return and review it from occasionally.

What types of cookies do CSE use?

CSE use performance cookies. We make use of analytic cookies to evaluate how our visitors use our website and to observe website performance. This allows us to provide a high-quality experience by tailoring what we offer, quickly identify and fix any issues that arise. We may use performance cookies to monitor which pages are most popular and to establish why some pages are receiving error messages. We might also use these cookies to identify articles or site services that we think will be of interest to you based on how you use the website. The information collected by these cookies is not related with any other personal information you share with us.

Use of addresses and web logs

We may also use your IP address and browser type to help detect problems with our server; to manage our website and to improve the service we offer to you. An IP address is a numeric code that recognises your computer on the internet. Your IP address might also be used to gather broad demographic information (e.g. geographical region, device type) for optimisation reasons.
